#### LAUGHTER YOGA!!

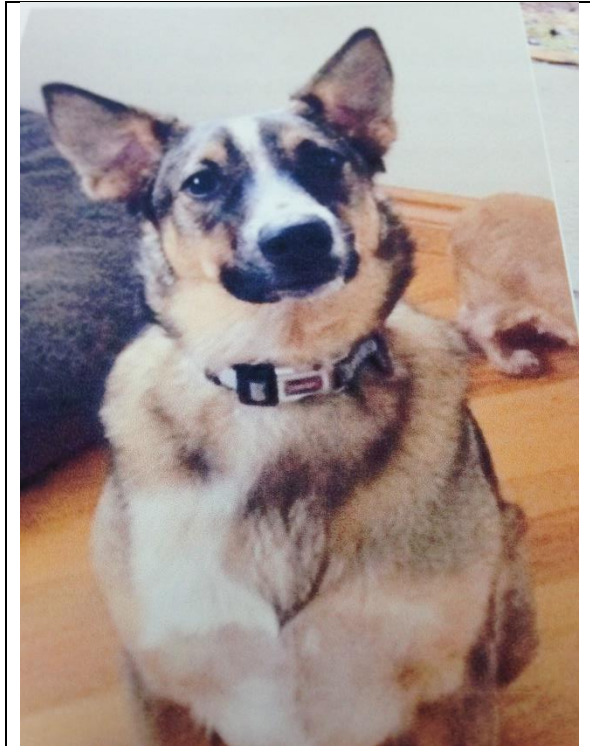
